Introduction:

The State of Himachal Pradesh is endowed by nature with diverse climatic conditions and ample natural resources. Agriculture is the main occupation of the people of Himachal Pradesh and has an important place in the economy of state. Himachal Pradesh is the only State in the country whose 89.96 percent population (Census 2011) lives in rural areas.

The contribution of agriculture and allied sector to GSVA at current prices has increased 53 per cent from ₹20,838 crore in FY2020-21 to ₹31,879 crore in FY2024-25 (Advance Estimates (AE)). There is a marked improvement in GSVA of crops at current prices between 2020- 21 to 2024-25 (from ₹12,341 crore in FY2020-21 to ₹21,912 crore in FY2024-25). The contribution of the crops sector to GSVA at current prices has increased by 78 per cent in the same period. Out of the total geographical area of 55.67 lakh hect, area of operational holding is about 9.44 lakh hect. and operated by 9.97 lakh. farmers. The average holding size is about 0.95 hect. Distribution of land holding according to 2015-16 Agriculture Census shows that 88.85 per cent of the total holdings belong to Small and Marginal farmers, about 10.85 per cent holdings are owned by Semi Medium and Medium farmers and only 0.30 per cent by large farmers. There has been a sustained growth of primary sector contribution to the State economy over the years. Between 2020-21 to 2024-25 (AE), GSVA (at current prices) of Agriculture, forestry, livestock and fisheries has seen a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 11.22 per cent in Himachal Pradesh. The crop sector was a major driver of this growth with a CAGR of 15.43 per cent, the sector's contribution to the GSVA of Agriculture and Allied activities has improved from 59.2 per cent in FY2020-21 to 68.7 per cent in FY2024-25. The share of agriculture and allied sector in total GSVA in the State has remained between 13-15 per cent in the last five years. Agricultural productivity is driven by a host of factors such as irrigation, use of quality seeds, Fertilizers and Pesticides, Extension services, Rural infrastructure etc. The potential for expanding output through area expansion is relatively limited. In terms of cultivable land, Himachal has already reached a plateau similar to the rest of the nation. Hence, emphasis is on increasing productivity levels besides diversification towards high value crops. Due to an increasing shift towards commercial crops, the area under food grain production is gradually decreasing, the area which was 853.88 thousand hectares in 1997-98 has declined to 688.69 thousand hectares in 2023-24.(GoHP Economic Survey,2024-25).

The major crops of the state are maize, paddy, millets and pulses during Kharif and wheat, barley, gram and other pulses during Rabi. During FY2024-25, food grains contributed around 41.75 per cent and commercial crops contributed 58.25 per cent of the total crop production of the state. Small millets and bajra production is estimated to increase by 76.15 per cent in the year 2024-25, 3.33 per cent increase in maize and (-)19.76 per cent decrease in wheat are estimated.

The Agency was also entrusted with the work of certification of organic farms and their produce and consequently its name was changed to H.P. State Seed and Organic Produce Certification Agency vide notification No. Agr. F(10)-16/2003 dated: 19.02.2004. Presently, the HP State Seed & Organic Produce Certification Agency has been authorized as Regional Council for organic certification under PGS-India certification system vide Authorization No. PGSI / NEC /RC-4715 dated: 27.04.2021 for Scope of Certification under Crop Production and Large Contiguous Area.

The Agency is following PGS-India certification system and this system is locally focused on quality assurance systems, built on a foundation of trust, social networks and knowledge exchange. In the case of organic agriculture, PGS is a process in which people in similar situations (in this case producers) assess, inspect and verify the production practices of each other and collectively declare the entire holding of the group as organic. PGS-India is facilitated by Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India through National Centre of Organic Farming (NCOF) as its Secretariat.

2.1 Objectives:

The main objective of the Himachal Pradesh State Seed & Organic Produce Certification Agency is to maintain high quality seeds of notified varieties and propagating materials and to ensure their genetic identity, known pedigree, high varietal purity and good seedling value through the process of certification. Certified seed has to meet the minimum standards of field as well as laboratory in respect of genetical and physical purity, health and germination etc. as per the Indian Minimum Seed Certification Standards prescribed by the Central Seed Certification Board.

To ensure that the seeds certified in the state conform to the standards prescribed by the Central Seed Certification Board, the Agency undertake the promotional activities for seed certification in the state and establish coordination with different departments of the State Government, Central Government, Agriculture and Horticulture Universities and other Agencies with regard to the certified seed production.

To ensure organic production, on-site inspections and records verification that farmers are following their organic system plan as per the norms laid by NCONF under PGS-India to minimize the risk of prohibited substances. Additionally, conduct residue testing to determine if these preventive practices are adequate to avoid contact with substances such as prohibited pesticides, antibiotics and GMOs. Any certified organic operation found to use GMOs or other prohibited substances may face enforcement actions, including loss of certification. Crops exposed to prohibited substances or GMOs may not be sold or labeled as organic; the crops may be sold as conventional, or “non-organic,” products.

2.2 Functions:

The main functions of the H.P. State Seed & Organic Produce Certification Agency are as under:-

- To act as the Certification Agency established under section 8 of the Seeds Act, 1966 (54 of 1966).
- To discharge the functions entrusted to the Certification Agency under Section 9 & 10 of the Seeds Act, 1966 (54 of 1966).
- Diffusion of scientific knowledge regarding standardization of seeds according to the National / International Standards and organic production as per NCONF guideline under PGS-India programme.
- To verify upon receipt of an application for certification that the application has been submitted in accordance with the procedure prescribed by the Central Seed Certification Board and that the source of seed, used for planting, is from approved sources.
- To do the inspections of seed processing plant and seed lots in accordance with the procedure outlined by the Central Seed Certification Board and inspection of organic farms/ farmers..
- To ensure that the seeds certified and organic farming in the state conforms to the standards prescribed by the Central Seed Certification Board and as per PGS-India guideline respectively.
- To undertake promotional activities for seed certification and organic production in the state.
- To establish coordination with different departments of the State Government, Central Government and other Agencies with regard to the certified seed production.

Seed Certification Offices are under the charge of Seed Certification Officers / Assistants at the following places:

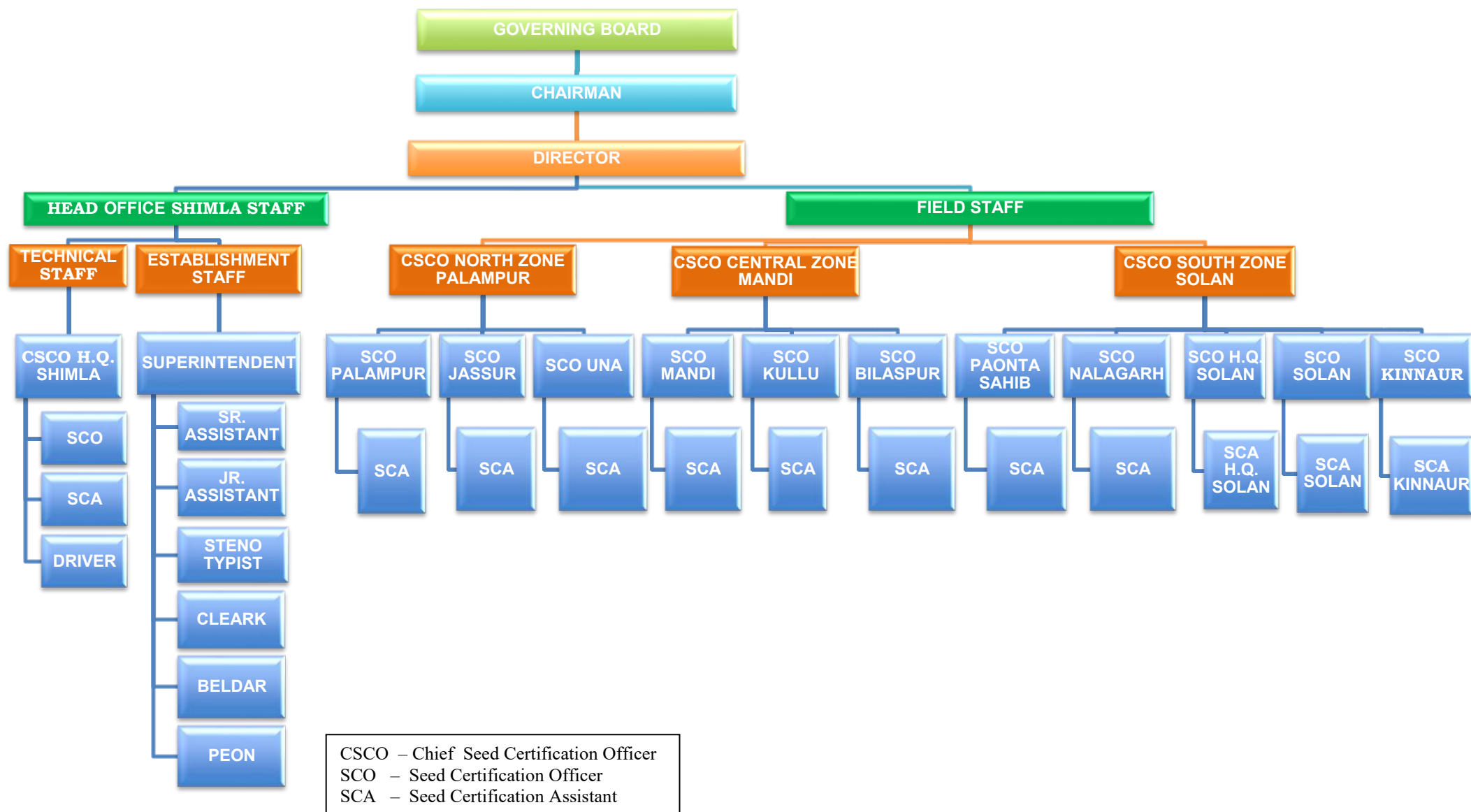

Seed Production, Monitoring and Certification

4.1 Monitoring of Breeder Seed:

The breeder seed is the progeny of nucleus seed and has inevitable significant importance in the seed production programme. The Breeder seed is produced under the direct supervision of the Breeder and is monitored in the field by a monitoring team constituted by Indian Council of Agriculture Research consisting of Director Seed Certification, nominee of National Seeds Corporation Ltd. and concerned Breeder. The names of the Research Stations which produced Breeder seed during 2024-25 are mentioned at **Annexure-2** and the area monitored for Breeder seed production during the year is given at **Annexure-3**.

4.2. Certification of Foundation Seed & Certified Seed:

Foundation seed is the progeny of breeder seed and multiplied at the seed multiplication farms belonging to the Department of Agriculture H.P. (**Annexure-4**) , CSK H.P. Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya Palampur Kangra and Dr. Y.S. Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry Nauni Solan and registered growers. Whereas, certified seed is the progeny of Foundation seed and this kind of seed is being produced in the state by the Department of Agriculture H.P. and on registered Private Growers' fields. The area of Foundation as well as Certified seed is registered with the H.P. State Seed & Organic Produce Certification Agency. The crops meant for such seed are inspected in the field by the Agency's staff to ensure that crops are free from diseased plants and there are no off type plants and weeds in such crops. These crops have to fulfill the minimum field standards as per Indian Minimum Seed Certification Standards-2013, prescribed by the Central Seed Certification Board, constituted by the Ministry of Agriculture, Govt. of India. After the harvesting of the crops, seed samples are taken and tested in the State Seed Testing Laboratories. If the samples of the seeds are found to meet the minimum seed standards, such seeds are allowed to be tagged and sealed by the Agency. The tagging and the sealing is done by the Agency staff observing all possible care to maintain the quality of the seed at the grading centers. The list of grading centers (Seed Processing Plants) is appended at **Annexure-5**.

During the year under report, the foundation and certified seed of different crops was produced in an area of **364.78 ha** during Kharif-2024 and **4855.02 ha** during Rabi-2024-25. The quantity of foundation and certified seed sealed under different crops was **18432.94 qtls** during Kharif-2024 and **59971.06 qtls** during Rabi-2024-25 (**Annexure-6-7**). The percentage of area under different group of crops and quantity of seed sealed during Kharif-2024 & Rabi-2024-25 has been depicted from **Figure-I to IV**, respectively. The area registered and quantity sealed of foundation and certified seed during last two years is given at **Annexure-8**.

The Agency has started working on Seed Authentication, Traceability & Holistic Inventory (SATHI) portal as per the direction of Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Government of India w.e.f. the year 2023-24, and area registered is also uploaded on the SATHI portal w.e.f. Kharif-2024 onward.

4.3 Area Registered and seed sealed since inception:

The Agency started the work of certification of seeds of different crops in the year 1979-80. Since its inception, the Agency has registered an area of **1,77,881.957 ha** and quantity sealed **54,37,956.985 qtls** of foundation and certified seed (**Annexure-9**).

4.4 PGS- India Organic Certification & Area Registered under PGS-India:

Under PGS-India Organic Certification, the registered farmers' fields on-site inspections and physical and records verification is being conducted that farmers are following their organic system plan as per the norms laid by NCONF under PGS-India to minimize the risk of prohibited substances. Additionally, conduct residue testing to determine, if these preventive practices are adequate to avoid contact with substances such as prohibited pesticides, antibiotics and GMOs. Any certified organic operation found to use GMOs or other prohibited substances may face enforcement actions, including loss of certification. Crops exposed to prohibited substances or GMOs may not be sold or labeled as organic; the crops may be sold as conventional, or "non-organic," products.

During the reporting year, total area registered under PGS-India during the year is **16229.55 ha**. Out of it, **16216.63 Ha**. area is registered under BPKP / PKVY Schemes, whereas **12.92 Ha** area is registered under non-scheme farmers. Total 772 no. of farmers' scope certificates has also been generated. The detail is annexed at **Annexure-10**.

Chapter-5

Financial Status

5.1. Receipt and Expenditure:

During the financial year 2024-25, Agency has generated total Receipt of **Rs. 469.31 lacs** against total Expenditure of **Rs. 183.80 lacs**. The major components of receipt are from agency's operations/ certification charges i.e. application & registration fee **Rs. 2.92 lacs**, Inspection fees **Rs. 21.93 lacs**, Sealing / Tagging Charges **Rs. 10.20 lacs**, Packing Supervision Charges **Rs. 10.20 lacs**, Processing Charges **Rs. 3.97 lacs**, Registration under Seed Village Scheme **Rs. 23.54 lacs** and Registration/ Physical Verification / Peer Appraisal & Residual Analysis charges under P.G.S India programme **Rs. 241.50 lacs**. Apart from this an amount of **Rs. 39.05 lacs** has also been generated by other petty charges. The certification charges being realized by the Agency per unit on account of services rendered by it are given at **Annexure-11 & Annexure-12**.

In addition to this, Agency has received a sum of **Rs. 116.00 lacs** from Govt. of Himachal Pradesh as Grant-in-aid. The major components for expenditure occurred in salary and administration cost.

Figure I: Area under different crops registered during Kharif 2024 (Percentage)

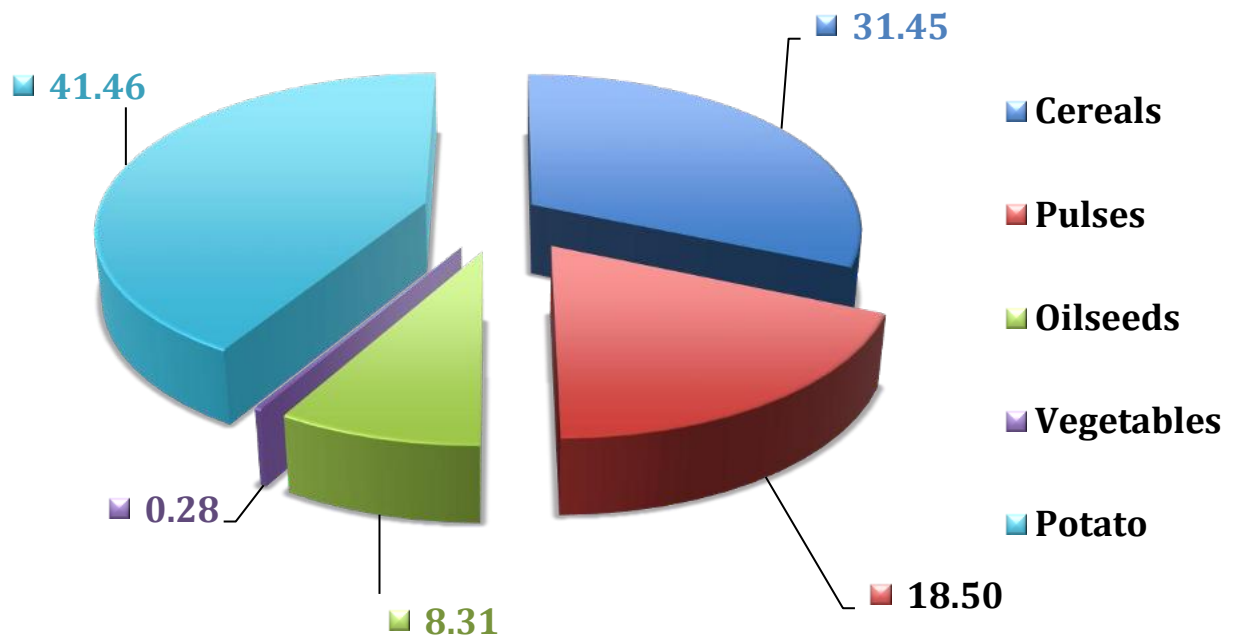


Figure II: Quantity of Seed Sealed during Kharif 2024 (Percentage)

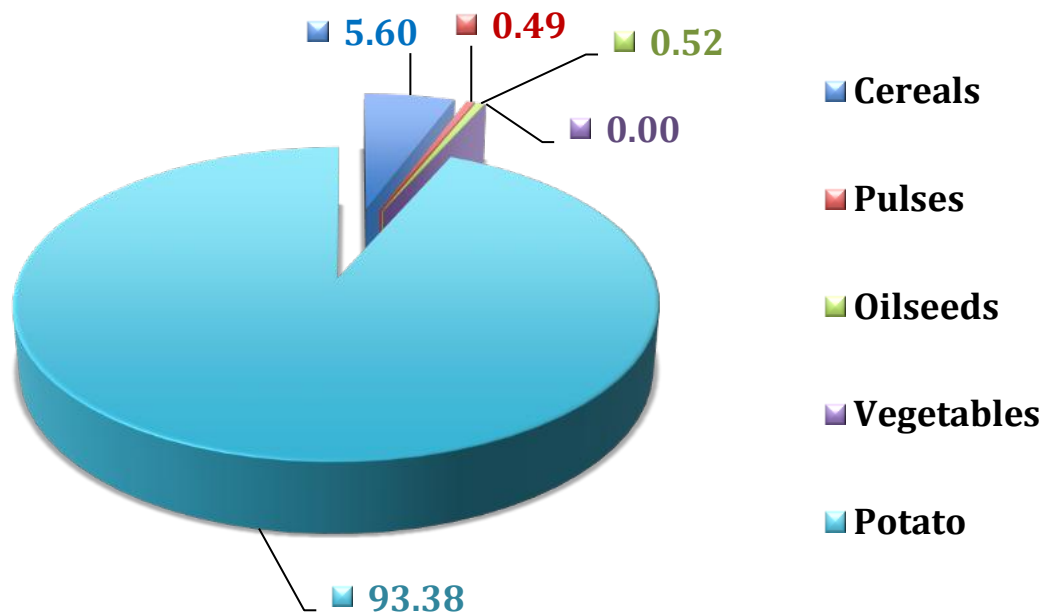


Figure III: Area under different crops registered during Rabi 2024-25 (Percentage)

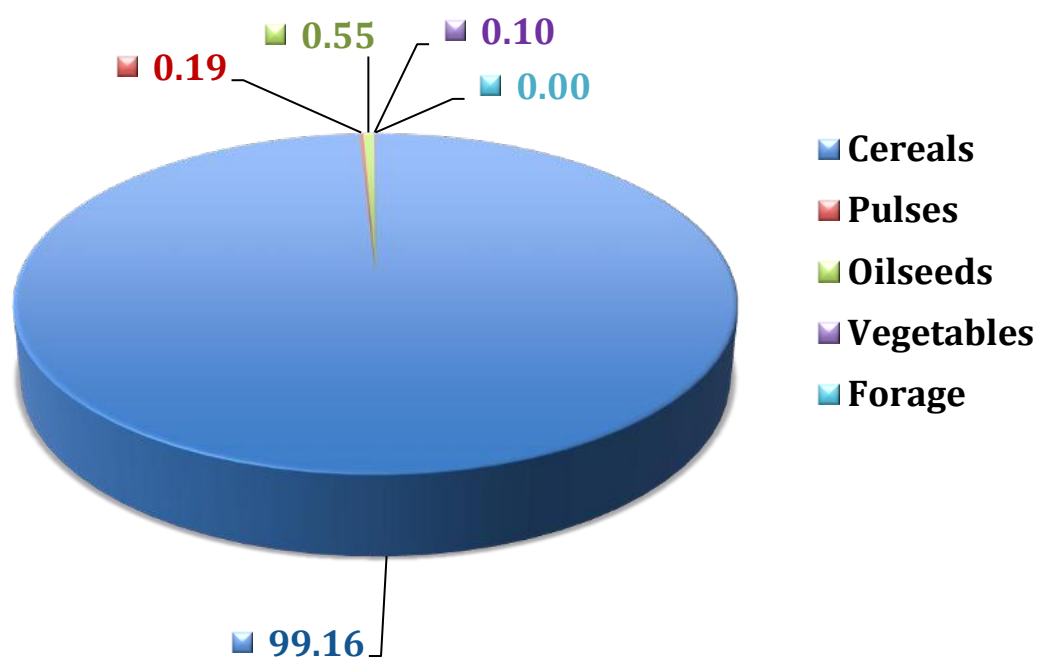


Figure IV: Quantity of Seed Sealed during Rabi 2024-25 (Percentage)

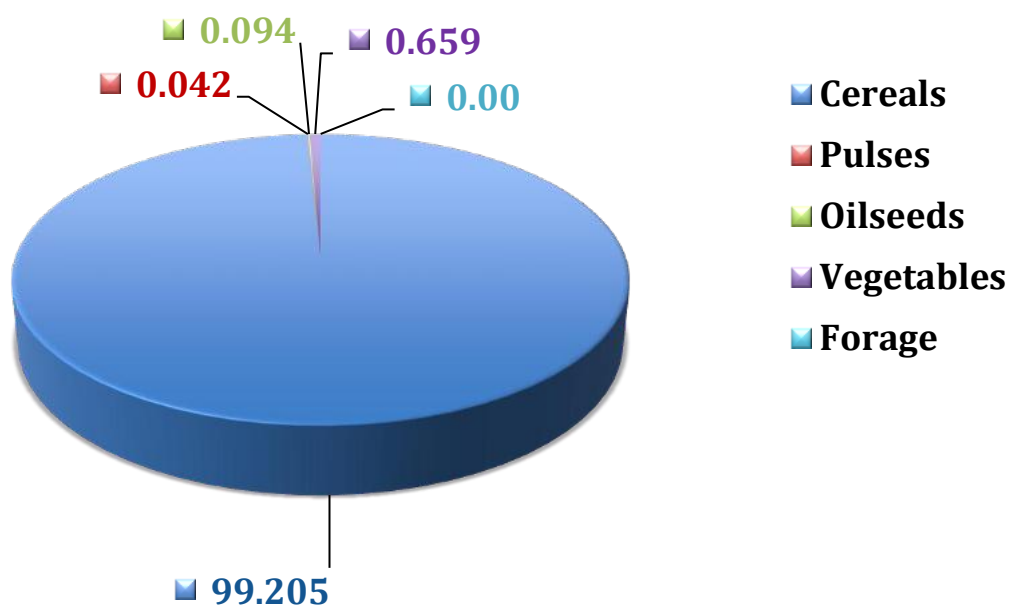
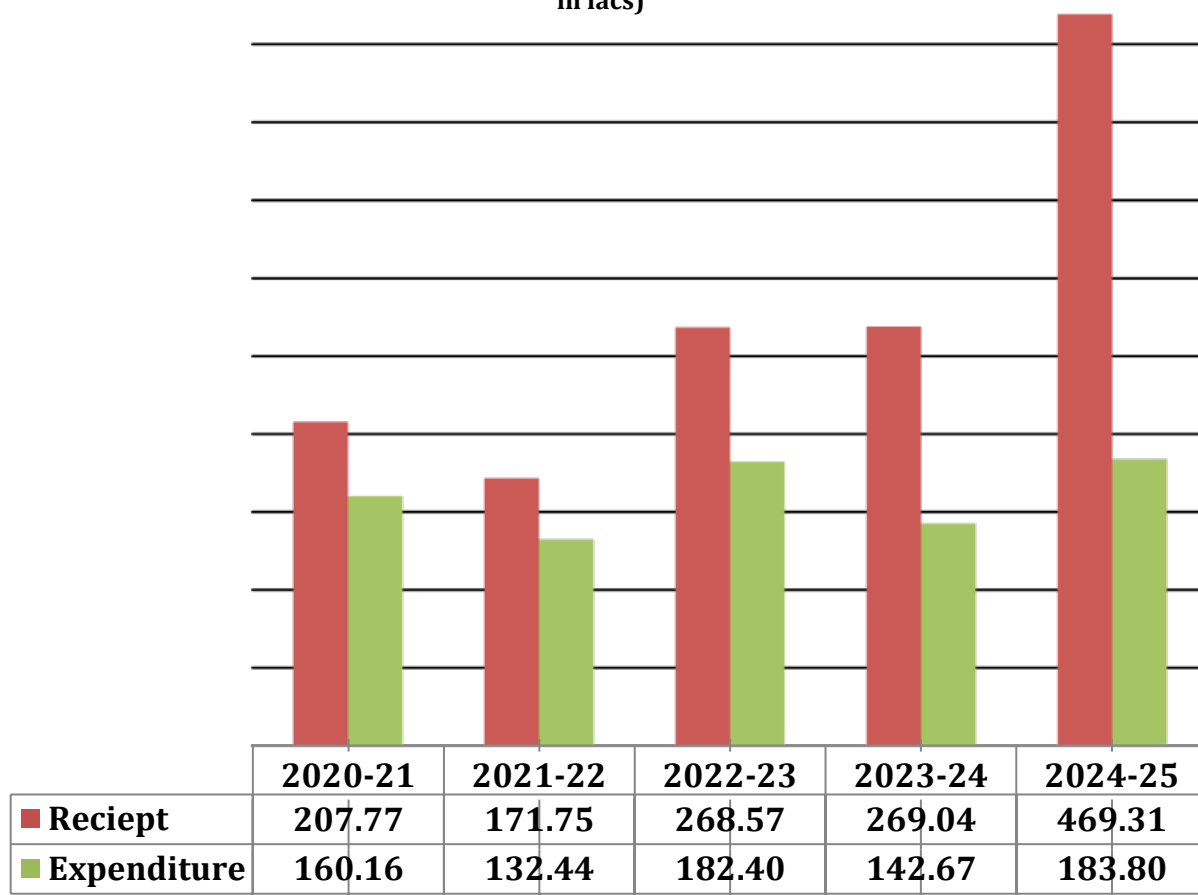


Figure V. Chart showing Receipts and Expenditure from 2020-21 to 2024-25 (Rs. in lacs)
